THE PROCEDURE OF ORGANIZING AND CONDUCTING THE OLYMPAID

- 1. The Olympiad is conducted in MSTU, the Faculty of Supplementary Education of Children and Adults on the basis of the Department of Russian as a Foreign Language.
 - 2. The Olympiad is conducted in two rounds:
- The first round is the competition of lexical, grammar and syntactical assignments on the Russian language;
- The second round is making a video clip according to one of the topics proposed.

The dates of the Olympiad

First round:

- 1. E-mail an application to participate in the Olympiad till 20 February, 2018 (<u>russian.language16@gmail.com</u>).
- 2. The assignments of the first round of the Olympiad will be placed on 20 February, 2018.
- 3. The participants do the assignments in a text document format (Microsoft Word 2003) and e-mail (russian.language16@gmail.com the Organizing Committee of the Olympiad) till 2 March, 2018. Further editing is not allowed.

Second round:

1. The topics for making video clips will be placed on the site of the Olympiad on 6 March, 2018.

The participants of the second round should e-mail their assignments (russian.language16@gmail.com - the Organizing Committee of the Olympiad) till 19 March, 2018. Further editing is not allowed.

Evaluation and reward

All the assignments will be evaluated according to the criteria for each round of the Olympiad. All the participants will get their certificates of participation and the Winners will be presented with diplomas.
